

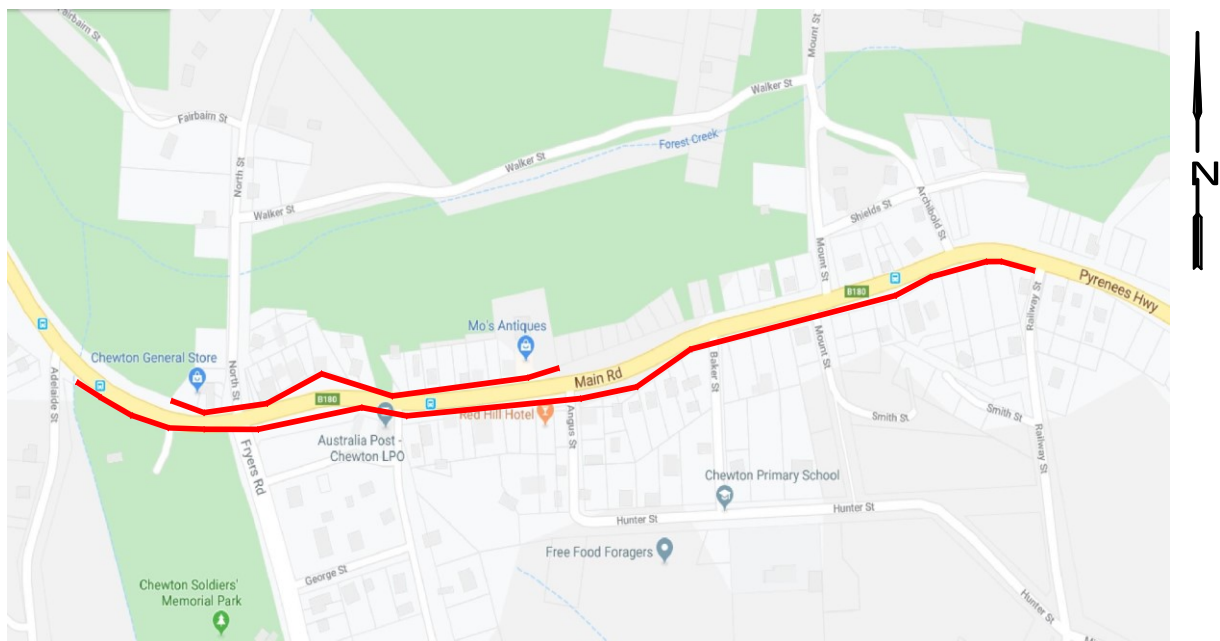
Footpath Construction, Chewton

Background

As part of Council's commitment to maintaining and upgrading our footpath network to ensure accessibility throughout the shire, a section of footpath in Chewton was identified for replacement as well as construction of new path sections.

This Project

Located along Main Street Chewton (Pyrenees Highway), the design allowed for construction of 880 metres of footpath between Adelaide Street and Railway Street on the southern side of the road and approximately 240 metres on the northern side running east from North Street. The extent of construction was dependent on tender submissions. An unmonitored (i.e. without traffic signal and zebra crossing) pedestrian crossing point was also constructed near the Chewton General Store at the intersection of Pyrenees Highway and North Street / Fryers Road. The area contains a mixture of commercial and residential properties, and care was taken during the construction period to minimise the impact to local businesses and residents.
