### **TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

  - o Creativity and originality will be considered
  - Derogatory names will not be considered

  - Submissions open to anyone under the age of 12 who live in the Mount Alexander Shire
  - o Entries must be submitted by 12/11/2023
  - All submitters consent to having their name and image used in Council communications
  - You may enter more than once
- Authorisation
  - Entering a name in the Name the Graders competition implies the acceptance of these rules.

## **OPEN & CLOSE DATES & TIMES**

The promotion commences at 12 midday Monday 23 October 2023 and closes 11.59pm on Sunday 12 November 2023 ("Promotional Period").

## **HOW TO ENTER**

- Information on how to enter & prizes form part of these Terms & Conditions. Any entry not
  complying with these Terms & Conditions is invalid. Entry into the Promotion or Competition is
  deemed to be an acceptance of these Terms & Conditions. All persons receiving this prize
  must be aged 12 years or under.
- 2. People may enter as many times as they like.
- 3. Entry is open to residents of Mount Alexander Shire Council who are 12 years old or younger.
- 4. Mount Alexander Shire Council employees are not eligible to enter this competition.
- 5. To enter, individuals should:
  - Add their name, age and school or preschool details to the colouring sheet and return to Council
  - Complete a specified competition form in person at the Civic Centre, Cnr Lyttleton & Lloyd Streets or any other event where Council Works Staff are present with specified forms
  - Compete a specified competition form supplied to your school, preschool or childcare organisation

- Council reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and reserves the right to disqualify any entrant for tampering with the entry process or for submitting an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms & Conditions.

If any prize remains unclaimed or forfeited through ineligibility or otherwise for 28 days after the competition close date, Council will conduct further draws, as required.
